Nashville No. 4 in U.S. for apartment investments

The Nashville-Middle Tennessee area ranks nationally as No. 4 for apartment investing, according to the Washington D.C.-based National Multi Housing Council.

The top five best cities for apartment investing in the United States are, in order of ranking: San Francisco; Salt Lake City, Utah; Oakland, Calif.; Nashville, Tenn.; Portland, Ore.

Nashville was the only Southeastern city to make the Top 10.

Other Southeastern cities that made the list of the best for apartment investing include Raleigh, N.C. at No. 11 and Atlanta at No. 48.

The list was announced at the 2008 annual meeting in Boca Raton, Fla.
